Our Playschool program is a program designed for children ages 3 months to 2 years of age. We are so happy to be able to offer a quality, safe program for your child. Below is some important information about Playschool.

Our Playschool II program will offer the children opportunity to play and learn! You must sign up for a permanent spot on permanent days so your child can be part of a specific class set. This will benefit your child by allowing teachers to prepare appropriate activities and daily lessons for the group. It also brings a more stable environment for your child. Your child will know the same children will be in his/her class each time he/she comes.

Prices are as follows: Registration Fee: Same as tuition price

Playschool I Babies (3 mths to -16 months) 8:30—11:15 a.m. MWF, T/Th, TWTh  
Playschool II (16 months—2 years) 8:30—11:15 a.m. MWF, T/Th, TWTh  
Registration Fee and tuition: 2 day-- \$140  
3 day-- \$160

If you have registered your child for Playschool I or II, you must begin paying tuition at the ***beginning of the school year in September***, even if you decide to send your child at a later date. Once you determine the day(s) you want to bring your child and sign up for those day(s), payment is due at the beginning of the month as a tuition payment.

**Class Time:** 8:30—11:30 a.m. Lunch and Learn is available for Playschool children until 12:45 p.m. The cost for Lunch and Learn is \$5 per day. A late fee is charged for each minute late pick-up from Lunch and Learn per child. ( See handbook)

**Class Size:** Playschool I 10 children per day with a teacher and an assistant  
Playschool II 12 children per day with a teacher and an assistant

**First Day of School: September 5, 8:30 a.m.** We do carpool for your Playschool II child. Your child will receive a school bag (clear plastic with school logo) if you have not received one previously. Your child will need the necessary bottles, diapers, change of clothes, snacks, etc. We do not administer medication.

A general overview of our Playschool program is given on the back of this sheet. Thank you for your interest in our Playschool program. We look forward to a wonderful experience with your child.

## **PLAYSCHOOL I**

**\*\*All items should be LABELED WITH YOUR CHILD’S NAME—bottles (ok for Playschool I—no bottles for Playschool II), diapers, clothing items, etc. Please send a change of clothing each day in your child’s bag. Please send food that you would like for us to feed your child during the day. We are sensitive to your child’s needs. If your child has a “lovey” or comfort item that is important at certain times . . . please let me know.**

Thank you for entrusting your child to us. We are honored to be able to help you nurture your child.

## **PLAYSCHOOL II**

**\*\*All items should be LABELED WITH YOUR CHILD’S NAME—especially their sippy cups(NO BOTTLES), lunch box (if staying for lunch bunch), diapers/pull-ups, and clothing items.**

**\*\*Remember to keep a set of clothes in the school bag (appropriate for the season and child’s size). Send a coat with your child. We will go outside to the playground in 40 degree and above weather. Our playground time is 9:30 a.m.**

**\*\*We will learn by exploring and doing activities in this class. Each day we will engage your child in some form of art activity; for example, playdoh, markers, crayons, finger paints and/or painting with a brush. We do use smocks and try to minimize the mess, however, children will get these items on their clothes from time to time. We ask that you keep this in mind when dressing your child for Playschool.**

**\*\*We will also be working throughout the year with reciting ABC’s, counting 1-10, primary color recognition, basic shape recognition, basic body part recognition (head, hair, fingers, toes, eyes, ears, nose). We will be learning prayer at snack time and begin our social skills with please, thank you sharing, yes ma’am, no sir, etc.**

We are sensitive to your child’s needs. If your child has a “lovey” or comfort object that is important at certain times, please let us know.

We are anticipating a GREAT year!! The children will learn, play hard, and most of all have a fantastic time. You are welcome in our classroom anytime. Please call me or let me know if you have questions, joys, and concerns. \_
